1. Applications must be submitted by an association member.
2. Nominees must be members in good standing of the National Association of REALTORS®, Oregon REALTORS® and the Central Oregon Association of REALTORS® and have no pending disciplinary actions on their license.
3. Some portion of the nominee's community work must have taken place during the last 12 months, but judges will also consider ongoing efforts outside of the 12-month window that demonstrates a depth of commitment.
4. Nominees should be able to document the results of their individual involvement through published reports and/or testimonials from the organization they served or the people they helped.
5. Nomination forms must be completed filled out and all sections included when submitted to the association office. Handwritten nominations outside of this designated form will not be accepted.
6. Grant amounts will only be issued to 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations.
7. One nominee will be selected each month and a contribution on their behalf will be made to their organization in the amount of \$500.
8. Annually, the nominees selected throughout the year will be judged together and one will be selected at the end of the year and recognized for their achievement at the COAR Annual Installation event. The nominee selected for this achievement will have a contribution made on their behalf to their organization in the amount of \$5000.
9. COAR will also circulate press releases on our monthly and annual winners and showcase the member in COAR publications.
